


#### CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - BRUSH STREET TO CASTRO STREET



#### CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - MLK JR WAY TO JEFFERSON STREET



### CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - JEFFERSON STREET TO CLAY STREET



### CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - CLAY STREET TO BROADWAY (1 OF 2)













#### CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - HARRISON STREET TO ALICE STREET




