


CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - BRUSH STREET TO CASTRO STREET



CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - MLK JR WAY TO JEFFERSON STREET



CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - JEFFERSON STREET TO CLAY STREET



CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - CLAY STREET TO BROADWAY (1 OF 2)



CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - CLAY STREET TO BROADWAY (2 OF 2)







EXTENDED SIDEWALK PLAN FROM WEBSTER ST TO HARRISON ST



CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - HARRISON STREET TO ALICE STREET



CURRENT PROPOSED PROJECT - ALICE STREET TO JACKSON STREET


