- VIII. Item 3: OYC Actions and Committee Reports
  - A. Digital Equity in CA

The Youth Commission submitted an additional 9 public comments to the State on the Broadband for All initiative to seek renewed investment in Oakland's broadband infrastructure to keep our most marginalized communities connected. We watched video footage of 4 of the public comments that were read on record at the state capitol on 1/24/24. And we read aloud 5 additional written e-comments on the State Digital Equity Plan that are and being reviewed by the Office of Broadband and Digital Literacy

(OBDL). Governor Newsome has reinvested 1.5 Billion into completing the Middle Mile Broadband infrastructure that runs down International Blvd and connects East Oakland.
