




NATURE PAVILION

COMMUNITY & TECHNICAL FEEDBACK

- Strong relationship to the trees and many opportunities to connect with the outdoors
- Visibility from MacArthur is great but main entrance should be closer to MacArthur
- Like that it does not displace many landscape program elements
- South area of park still does not feel activated, especially tennis and amphitheatre
- Moss House is very visible from inside the building
- Temp rec center can still be used during construction
- Requires electrical service upgrade
- Utility connection from MacArthur
- Taller trees impact PV panels on roof
- Outdoor utility yard requires vehicle access from street












DIALOGUE WITH HISTORY

COMMUNITY & TECHNICAL FEEDBACK

- Like that former building location is reused so site impact is minimized.
- Like that trees and existing landscape program elements are preserved.
- Creates opportunities to use community center space to support Moss House events.
- Building creates undesirable barrier between park and tennis courts.
- Pool location is not strong because it cannot open to Moss House or Amphitheatre.
- · Requires electrical service upgrade
- Utility connection from Webster
- May be able to reuse existing utilities which would lower cost
- Better than option 1 from mechanical perspective because there is less west-facing facade and most non occupied spaces are on south side
















Nature Pavilion














Secretary of the Interior's Standards for Rehabilitation

- NEW CONSTRUCTION NEEDS TO BE BUILT IN A MANNER THAT PROTECTS THE INTEGRITY OF THE HISTORIC BUILDING AND THE PROPERTY'S SETTING.
 - NEW CONSTRUCTION PLACED
 AT THE SIDE OR REAR OF
 HISTORIC BUILDINGS AND AVOID
 OBSCURING OR DESTROYING
 CHARACTER-DEFINING FEATURES
 OF THE BUILDING.
- PROTECTING THE HISTORIC SETTING AND CONTEXT OF A PROPERTY.
- NEW CONSTRUCTION SHOULD ALSO BE DISTINCT FROM THE OLD AND MUST NOT ATTEMPT TO REPLICATE HISTORIC BUILDINGS ELSEWHERE ON SITE AND TO AVOID CREATING A FALSE SENSE OF HISTORIC DEVELOPMENT.
- HISTORIC LANDSCAPES AND SIGNIFICANT VIEWSHEDS MUST BE PRESERVED.


























































MOSS HOUSE ROOF PLAN
