
## 81% of survey respondents preferred a Class I off-street walking & biking path

between Camden & Sunnymere over on-street separated bike lanes


Having a path for bikers and walkers, away from cars, is wonderful! I love the path on MacArthur and see folks using it everyday to jog, walk, and bike.





#### LAMMPS 3 - Main Project Components


- Class 1 off-street walking & biking path on University side
- Uphill: Reduction to 1 lane; Downhill: 1 lane solidified
- Shorter crossing distances
- Closure of sidewalk gaps (residential side)




### Closing Sidewalk Gaps



Winter 2023/24	Initial Design (15%) Completed
<b>Early 2024</b>	Outreach on Initial Design
Late Summer/Fall 2024	Share 35% Design
2027	Construction (ideally LAMMPS 2 & 3)
