# Mobile Food Vending Permit

Food Trucks, Trailers, and Sidewalk Vendors



To vend food or non-alcoholic beverages from the public right-of-way, private or city owned property you must have a City of Oakland Mobile Food Vending Permit. Applications available at:

A vendor is a person who sells food or non-alcoholic beverages on the public right-of-way, private or city owned property from a food truck, trailer, pushcart, stationary cart or other equipment allowed by the Alameda County Environmental Health Department.

There are two types of vendors:

**Roaming Vendor** moves from place to place and stops only to make a sale.

**Stationary Vendor** sells from a fixed location e.g. public right-of-way, private or city owned property.

#### Where can I vend?

Roaming Vendors that comply with sidewalk clearances, buffer distances and special permissions\* may sell in commercial and industrial zones.

Permitted Roaming Sidewalk vendors may vend throughout the city.

**Stationary Vendors** that comply with sidewalk clearances, buffer distances and special permissions\* may sell on private or city owned property within a commercial or industrial zone. Vendors must meet Health Department and City requirements before vending.

All Vendors are responsible for complying with any and all parking laws e.g. paying meters, red, yellow, and green zone requirements.

#### \*Sidewalk Clearances


- The vending facilities must maintain a 6-foot
- minimum clear path of travel along the sidewalk. See the City Administrator
- Emergency Order on the Flex Streets
- <u>Initiative</u> for additional clearance requirements, such as distances from bus
- stops, fire hydrants, curb ramps, building entrances and others.

#### \*Special Permissions

- Parks:To vend in City of Oakland parks,
- vendors must also get permission from
- the City of Oakland Department of Parks, Recreation and Youth Development.
  - 666 Bellevue Avenue, Oakland (510) 238-3420
- **Schools**: Vending within 300 feet of any school is only allowed if a waiver is granted
- by the school's Supervising Entity to sell healthy food.

#### \* Buffer Distances

- Mobile Food Vending is not allowed within:
  - 300 Feet of any other Mobile Food Vendor
- I00 Feet from other sidewalk Vendors
  - 300 Feet of a Restaurant or Café
  - 300 Feet of Schools
- 300 Feet of a Farmer's Market, Flea Market, or other Special Event (like "First Friday" or "Off the Grid")



General Liability Insurance is required; Worker's Compensation Insurance may also be required. See Mobile Food Vending website for detailed insurance requirements.






#### Fire Clearance

- pm daily. Late night vending may be
- allowed if adjacent businesses are
- open late.
- The regular permitted hours for all other vendors are 7 am to 10
- pm daily. Vendors may apply for late
- night vending.
