Theft Notification Requirements

- §15036. Notification of Theft, Loss, and Criminal Activity.
 - (a) A licensee shall notify the Department and local law enforcement within 24 hours of discovery of any of the following situations:
 - (1) The licensee discovers a significant discrepancy, as defined in section 15034, in its inventory.
 - (2) The licensee discovers diversion, theft, loss, or any other criminal activity pertaining to the operations of the licensee. Department of Cannabis Control Medicinal and Adult-Use Commercial Cannabis Regulations (September 2023) Page 62 of 224
 - (3) The licensee discovers diversion, theft, loss, or any other criminal activity by an agent or employee of the licensee pertaining to the operations of the licensee.
 - (4) The licensee discovers loss or unauthorized alteration of records related to cannabis or cannabis products, customers, or the licensee's employees or agents.
 - (5) The licensee discovers any other breach of security. (b) The notification to the Department pursuant to subsection (a) shall be submitted on the Licensee Notification and Request Form, Notifications and Requests Regarding Regulatory Compliance, DCC-LIC-028 (New 2/22), which is incorporated herein by reference, and shall include the date and time of occurrence of the theft, loss, or criminal activity, the name of the local law enforcement agency that was notified, and a description of the incident including, where applicable, the item(s) that were taken or lost.
 - Authority: Section 26013, Business and Professions Code. Reference: Section 26070, Business and Professions Code.

How to report a theft

- First, you need to download a copy of the DCC Form 28. This form can be found on the Department of Cannabis Controls website.
 - DCC website >Licensees> Licensee Resources (CannaConnect)> Notifications and Requests> Form28:Notification and Requests Regarding Regulatory Compliance
- Second, fill out the form completely and gather any supporting documents. I.e. video surveillance, police reports, stolen inventory list, affected UID's etc.
- Lastly, email the Form 28 and supporting documents to Compliance@cannabis.ca.gov
 - Make sure the email to includes the following:
 - Provide the name of the responding law enforcement agency and the report number
 - Provide the stolen inventory list including the UID, product name, quantity and value
 - Upload surveillance footage of the incident to: (Drop box link provided)
 - Provide receipts and/or invoices for repairs made to the premise

Property Descriptions

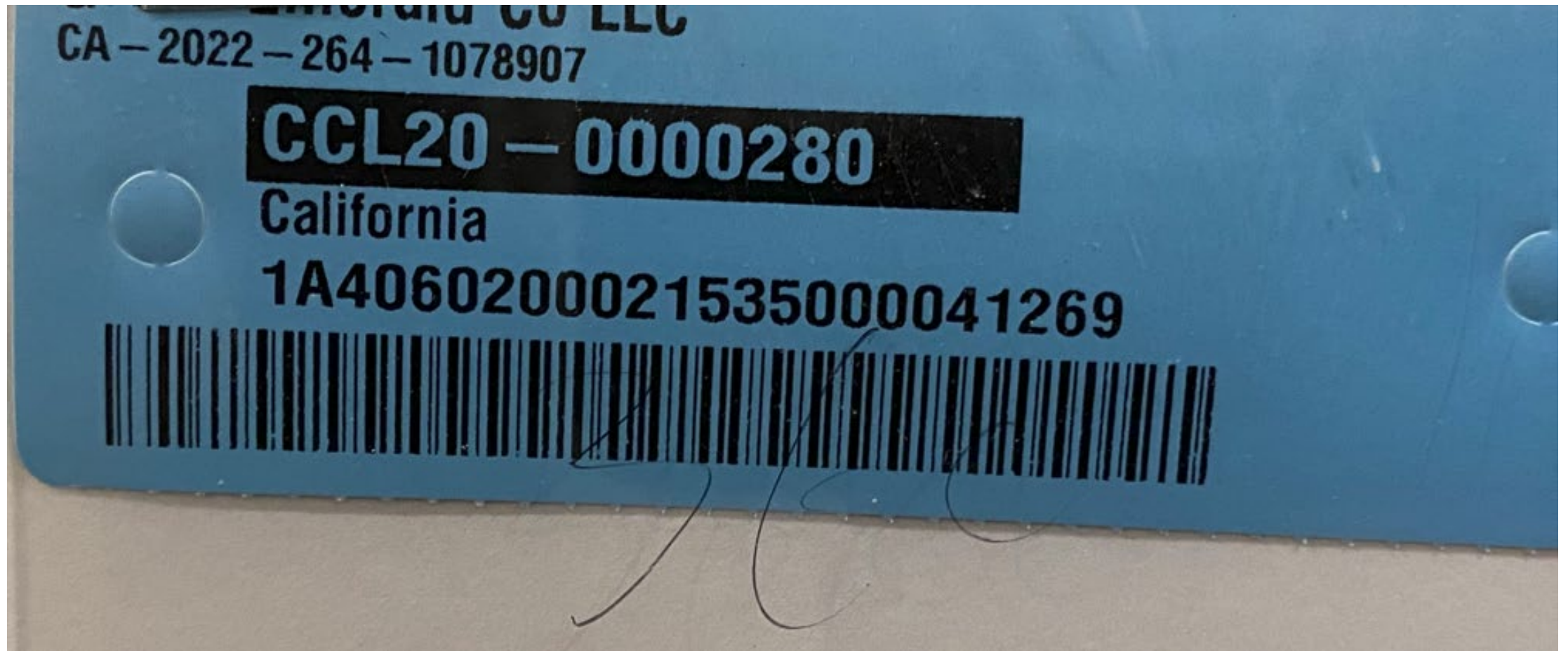
- Please include track and trace information (UID) to the police officer taking the report.
- Including the UID information in your crime is vital in making a direct association with the reported crime and loss taken during that incident.
- Possession of stolen cannabis products is a violation of P.C. 496 – Possession of stolen property. The attached UID information is used to determine if the products have been reported as loss by a victim of one of the mentioned crimes.

Types of Crime

- P.C. 459 – Burglary, forced entry into a structure (or vehicle) resulting in loss of or any item of value.
- P.C. 215 – “Car Jacking” Taking a vehicle by force or fear while occupied.
- C.V.C 10851 – Stolen Vehicle Taking a vehicle without the owner's permission.
- P.C. 211 – Use of force or fear to take property from an individual.
- P.C. 487 – Grand theft (Over \$950 Value)
- P.C. 484- Theft (Under \$950 Value)

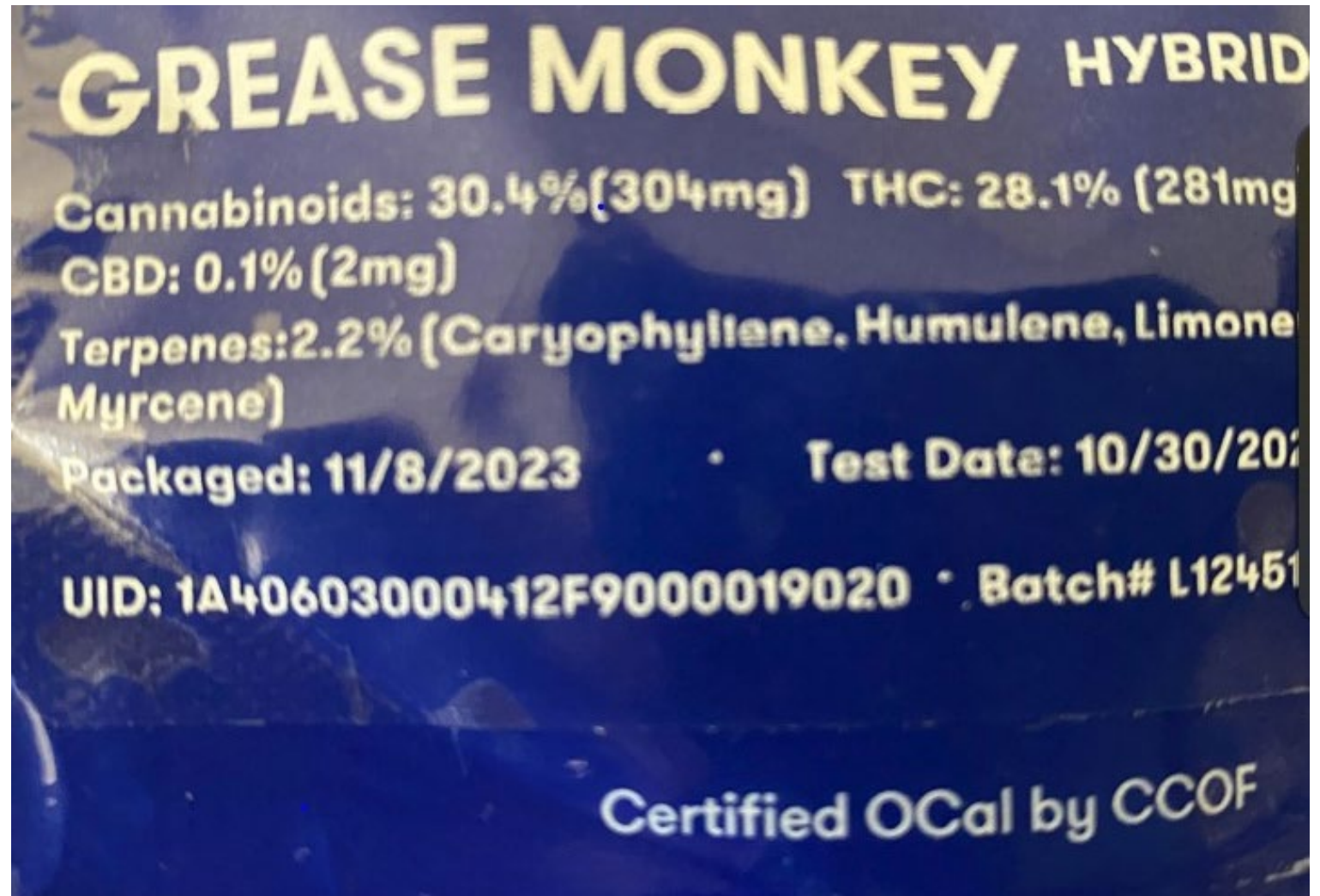

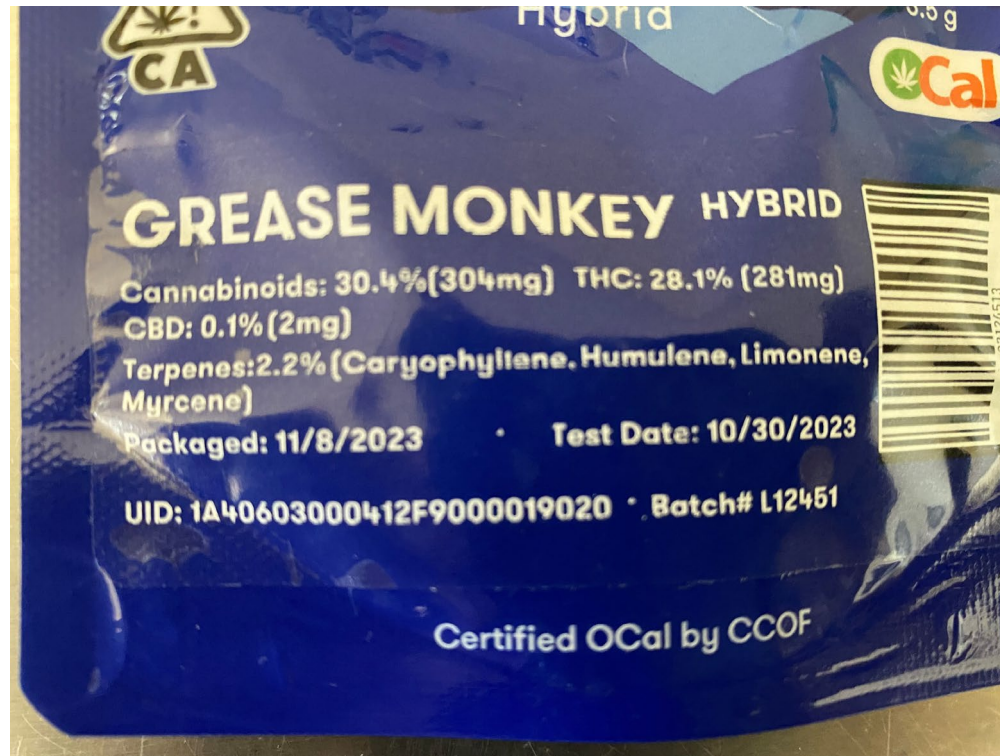


Metric – Track and Trace UID

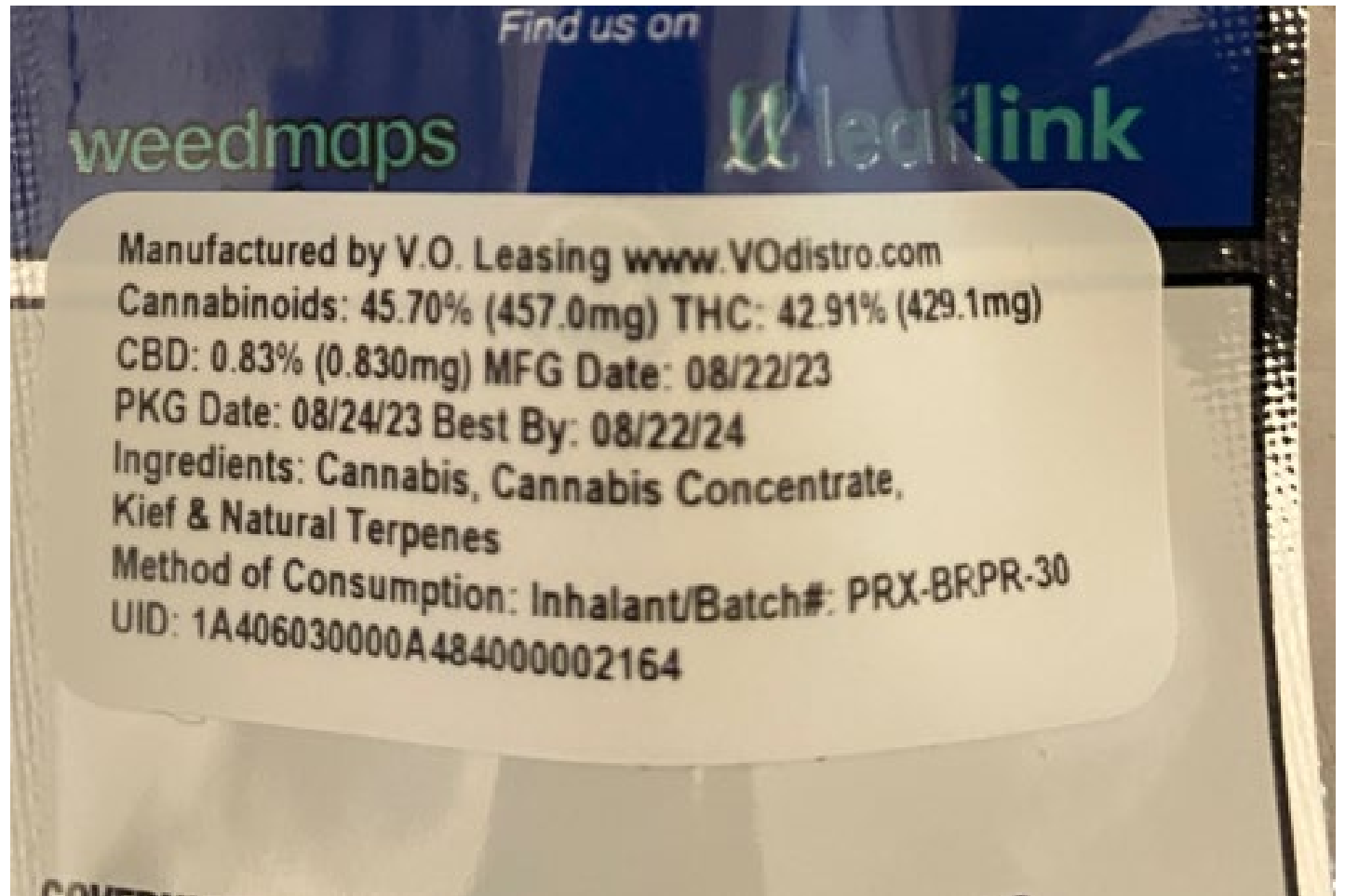

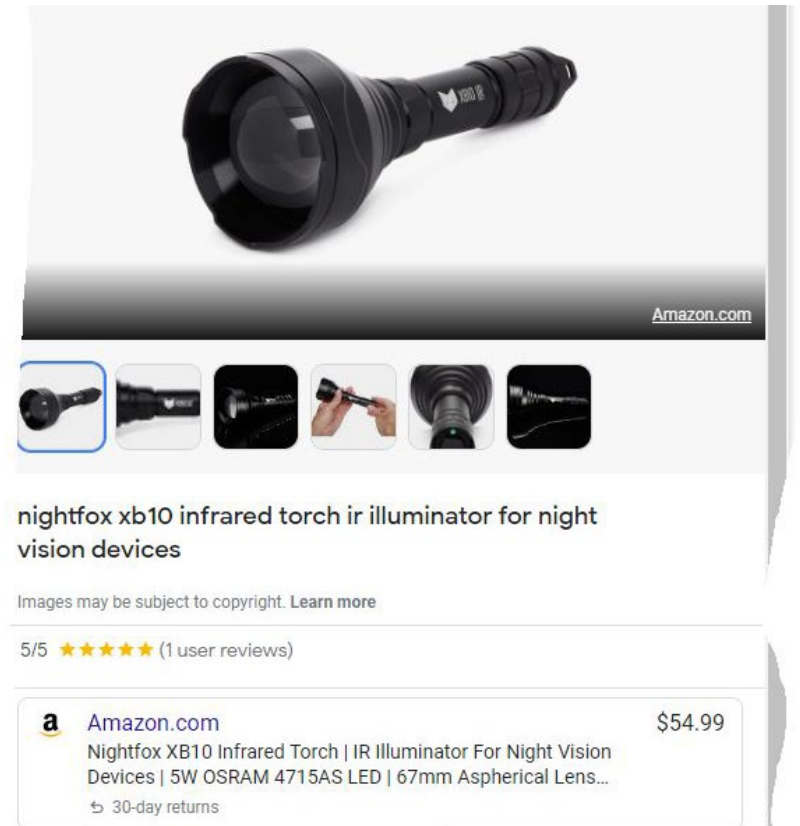

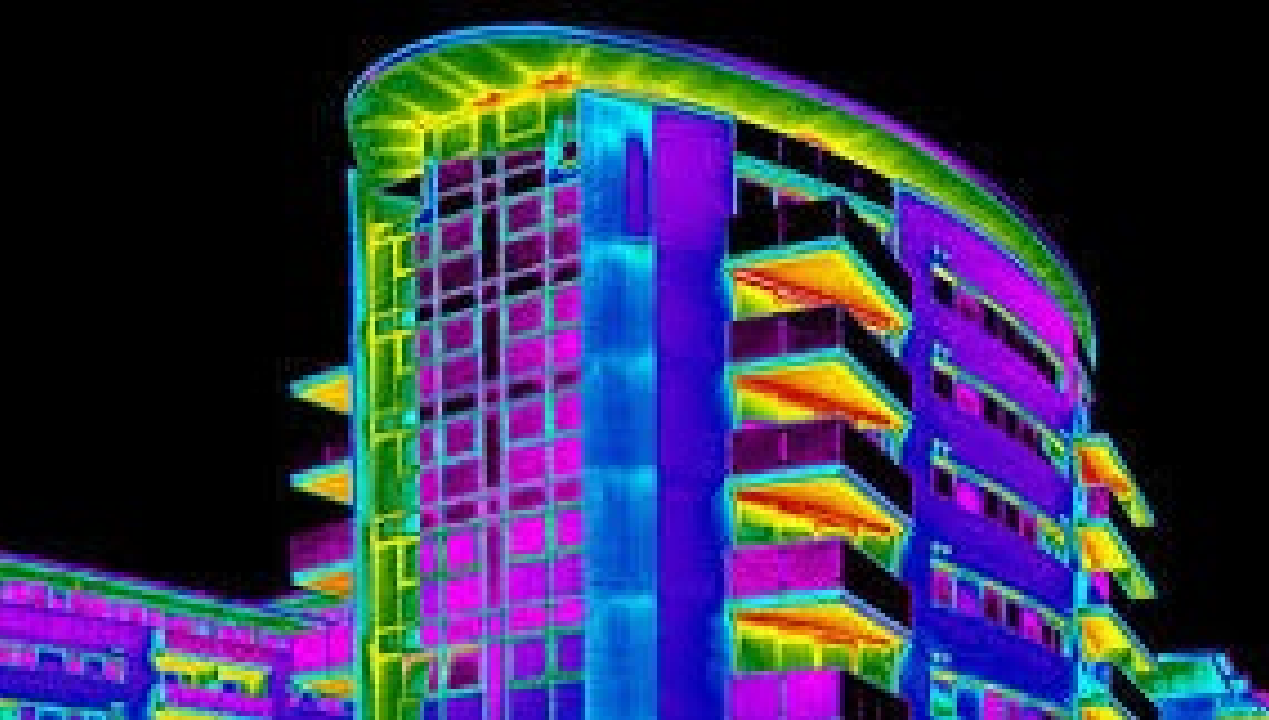
