Creation of the Oakland Redistricting Commission

As you may know, last year the City of Oakland underwent a redistricting process for the districts lines that apply to City Council and Oakland School Board districts. The redistricting process in 2013 attempted to engage the broader community and encourage citizen participation by those impacted by the lines drawn in the final map. While last year's process was better than in decades past, I strongly believe that these decisions should not have be made by the elected officials who stand to benefit from them.

As we look forward to the next decade, we have an opportunity to make future redistricting more democratic by putting the decision-making power into the hands of Oakland residents who are neither elected officials nor political insiders. This can be done through the creation of an independent Redistricting Commission. In the spirit of the democratic process, please take a moment to complete a brief survey on how a Redistricting Commission might look for Oakland.
