Policy Clarifications and Proposed Revisions

- Language and applicability of policies regarding refusal vs. failure to comply.

Questions and Concerns Raised

Custody of Prisoners

- o Potential risks and concerns regarding deaths in custody.
- Agreement to review specific policies related to prisoner management.

• Truthfulness Policy

- Discussion on exceptions allowing officers to mislead (e.g., during interrogations or undercover work).
- Concerns about ambiguity in "official duties" language and how it applies to different scenarios.

• Refusal to Provide Name or Serial Number

- o Differentiation between refusal and failure due to situational constraints.
- Suggested need for classifications or tiers of violations based on context and intent.

Suggestions and Recommendations

1. Policy Revisions:

- Add clarity to ambiguous policy language (e.g., "upon request" and "official duties").
- Consider introducing a lesser offense classification ("failure" vs. "refusal") for certain infractions.

2. Documentation and Transparency:

Ensure all exceptions (e.g., lying for official duties) are well-documented in reports.

 Provide written guidance or examples to clarify scenarios, particularly regarding truthfulness and use of force.

3. Preparation for Next Meeting:

- Distribute updated policies and related documents ahead of the next session.
- o Include policies on juveniles, informant interactions, and interrogations for review.

Next Steps

- Lt. G. Dorham: Share updated documents, including policies on use of force, custody of prisoners, sexual misconduct, and juveniles.
- Chair Ricardo Garcia-Acosta: Coordinate agenda for next meeting and ensure focus on pinned topics.

- o Refusal to Provide Name or Serial Number (explore introducing "failure" classification).
- Truthfulness Policy with examples and implications for juveniles and informants.
