Main Topics Discussed

Truthfulness Policy

- Termination as the sole consequence for sustained violations.
- Discussion on defining scenarios where technical violations might occur without malicious intent.

• Juvenile Interactions Policy

- o Importance of safeguarding juveniles against harmful tactics.
- Suggestions for creating a dedicated juvenile interaction policy section.

• Use of Force Policies

- Classification and review process for levels of force (Levels 1-4).
- o Discussion on excessive force versus procedural violations.

• The potential need for classifying minor procedural violations separately.

• Refusal to Provide Name or Serial Number

- Discussion on maintaining accountability and officer transparency.
- Deliberation on whether to include a Class 2 violation option for unintentional lapses.

Discipline Matrix Adjustments

• Exploration of adding counseling and training for first-time offenses in certain scenarios.

Questions and Concerns Raised

• Truthfulness Policy:

- Can procedural errors versus intentional violations be treated differently within the current structure?
- Are there carve-out options for cases without malice?

• Juvenile Policy:

- How can we ensure community trust is not jeopardized by improper juvenile interactions?
- Should there be clear delineations between minor and major policy violations involving juveniles?

• Use of Force:

- Is there a risk of officers being overly disciplined for technical mistakes?
- Should there be greater emphasis on outcomes or actions taken during force incidents?

• Name and Serial Number:

- Could allowing a Class 2 option undermine the importance of officers identifying themselves?
- How can supervisors fairly assess cases of genuine misunderstanding or oversight?

Suggestions and Recommendations

Truthfulness Policy:

Develop clearer guidelines to distinguish technical violations from intentional deceit.

• Juvenile Interactions Policy:

Create a standalone policy section addressing juvenile-specific protocols and restrictions.

• Use of Force:

- Allow for incremental classifications (Class 2) for lower-level violations without watering down accountability.
- Conduct further review of the Discipline Matrix to ensure fair proportionality.

• Name and Serial Number:

- Retain Class 1 status but introduce disciplinary discretion based on mitigating circumstances.
- o Emphasize officer training on the importance of prompt identification.

• Discipline Matrix Adjustments:

Incorporate counseling and training as an initial step for first-time procedural lapses

- Draft revisions for truthfulness and juvenile interaction sections.
- Develop recommendations for incremental force classifications.
