A. Call to Order/Approval of Agenda

D. Presentation - Guillermo Cespedes, Chief of Violence Prevention

The Board welcomed Guillermo Cespedes, Oakland's Violence Prevention Chief. Mr. Cespedes presented the demographics and geography of Oakland's crimes, the progress being made and the challenges ahead. Mr. Cespedes outlined the hot spots across the map, revealing 52% of homicides and shootings occur in only 10 of the 35 police beats in Oakland. To date, the city has seen a 48.1% reduction in homicides. Mr. Cespedes discussed the many challenges ahead, and underscored the need for a more comprehensive and effective approach to supporting the families of homicide victims. This call to action, to support families of homicide victims, was acknowledged by the Board and will be sent to the Advocacy Committee Agenda.

E. Community Action Partnership (CAP) Updates (E. Clemons)

1. Board Update
