A. Call to Order/Recite AC-OCAP Promise

G. Green called the January 11, 2021 Administering Board Teleconference to order at 5:38 p.m. The AC-OCAP Promise was recited.

B. Roll Call/Determination of Quorum/Approval of Agenda

D. Open Forum

Community Member A. Olugbaba provided a comment on AC-OCAP's mission statement.

E. Presentation by Honorable Mayor of Oakland Libby Schaaf

Mayor Libby Schaaf was introduced by E. Clemons and welcomed by the Administering Board. Mayor Schaaf, a former AC-OCAP Board member, stated she was very proud of the board's incredible efforts to end poverty. Recognizing the tough year of loss and suffering, Mayor Schaff shared a chart illustrating the seriousness of the current COVID-19 surge. Alameda County is working hard to accelerate the rate of vaccinations for essential health care workers, seniors living in community care environments, and residents at the greatest risk of infection. Images of all civic and health officials that make up the Racial Disparities Task Force were shared on the teleconference screen. The Task Force is an intensive partnership with lawmakers, city, and county governments who are leading the COVID response. The Task Force mission was two-pronged, first was to provide a rapid response to reduce disparities that were seen by race, geography, and job class. Second, is to create a long-term policy agenda so these disparities would not be experienced in the future. Mayor Schaaf then moved from the topic of COVID-19, to address the big picture – Guaranteed Income. The last slide shared on the Teleconference screen was a photo of Mayors for Guaranteed Income (MGI), made up of 30 mayors across the country promoting guaranteed income as a federal policy, to include direct, recurring cash payments to families based on need. MGI believes that the fastest way to address poverty and racial inequities is to provide Guaranteed Income. With a question-and-answer session, Mayor Schaff concluded her update to the AC-OCAP Administering Board.

To ensure a representative for Oakland District 1 is found, Casey Farmer has become an AC-OCAP Ambassador. In collaboration with Claudia Albino from the office of Supervisor Nate Miley, the CAP Staff received a board member nominee from unincorporated Alameda County.

B. Oakland District 3 and 7 Elected Officials

There are two new district council members, District 3 Carroll Fife, and District 7 Treva Reid. Official welcome letters are being drafted and introduction meetings are scheduled.
