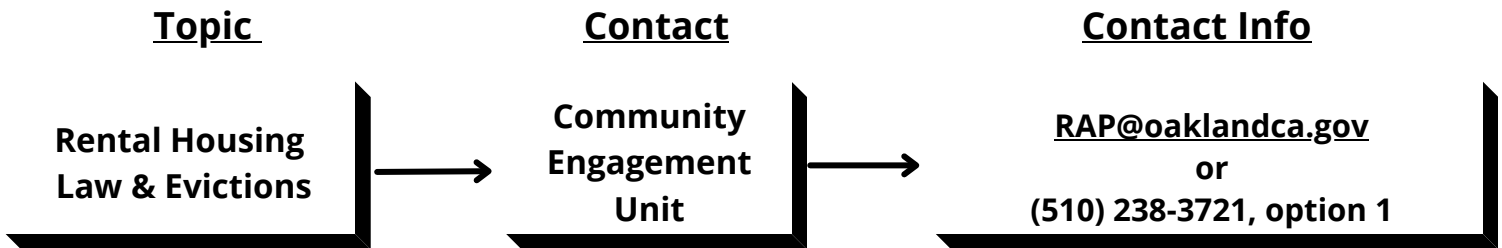
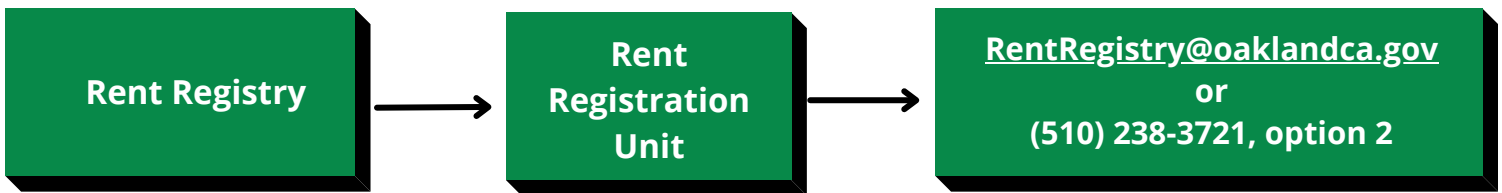




HOW TO CONTACT THE RENT ADJUSTMENT PROGRAM

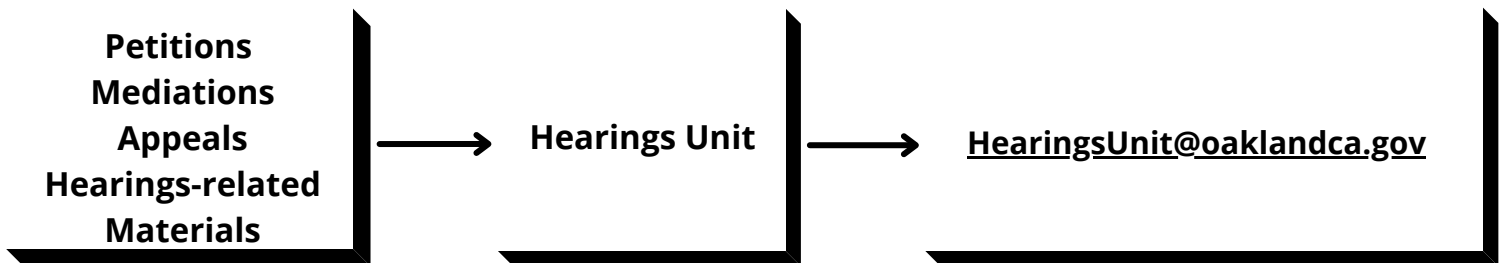

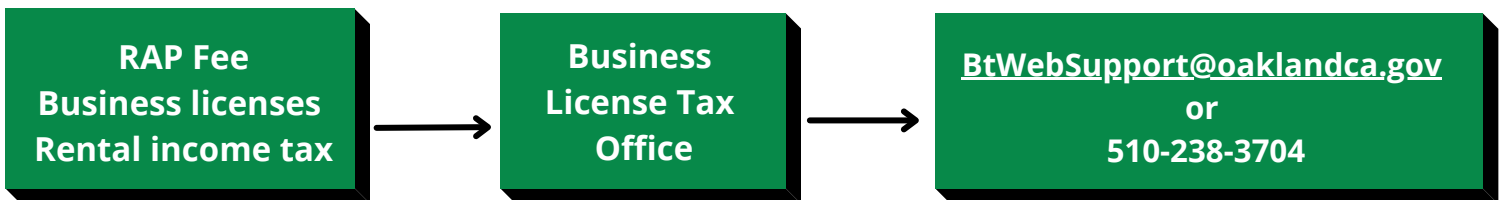


Rent Registration Unit: Beginning July 3, 2023, owners of rental units subject to the RAP Fee will need to provide tenancy information for each covered unit on an annual basis.

Hearings Unit: Property owners and tenants may petition our office for rent adjustments, appeals, and mediation. Petitions are presided over by an impartial RAP Hearing Officer.



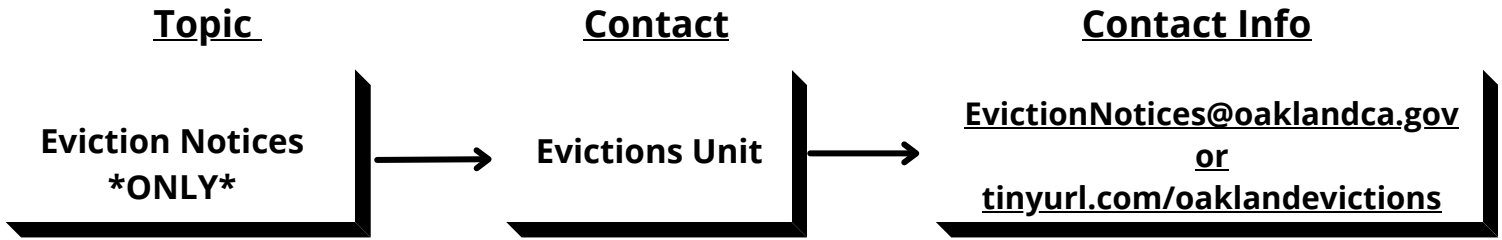
The Business License Tax Office : Oakland owners of residential rental units must register & obtain a license to operate their rental unit(s). As of 2024, the non-refundable RAP fee is \$101.

Note: The RAP does not collect the RAP fee.

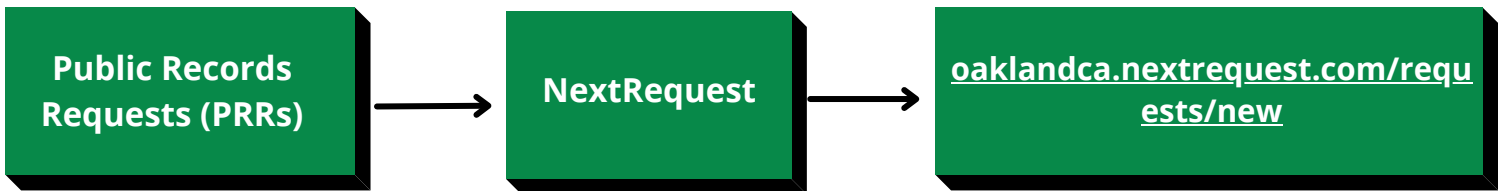


HOW TO CONTACT THE RENT ADJUSTMENT PROGRAM



Evictions Unit: Property owners must file a copy of every eviction notice they serve on the tenant within 10 days. Notices may be filed via email, the online portal, or mail.

Contact the Community Engagement Unit for eviction process-related questions.



Public Records Requests: All public records requests (PRR) must be made on the NextRequest website. Personal information will be redacted. Please use the NextRequest link in your email, which contains your request number, for follow-up inquiries.
