INFORMATION

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an update to the 2020 U.S. Census data for the City of Oakland. The Redistricting Commission's consultant (Redistricting Partners) has prepared a report (*Attachment A*) for the Commissioners and the information is being shared with the Mayor, City Council, staff and the public.

On April 1, 2020, Oakland's population was 440,749. This represents an increase of 49,916 residents or 12.8% since the last decennial census. In comparison terms, the population for the State of California grew by 6.1% over this same period.

The largest district population growths occurred in District 3 (14,656 additional residents, 25.6% increase) and District 7 (10,192 additional residents, 18.4% increase). The attached report includes further demographic statistics by existing districts.

It is important to note that the 2020 Census data is not the final population numbers that will be used in the 2021 redistricting process. Per State legislation, redistricting must factor incarcerated populations when redrawing district boundaries. The State is currently processing that information and the Commission should receive the final population data in mid-September.

Additional population information will be shared as it becomes available. Staff will also assist in coordinating information about the City's redistricting process to the Mayor and City Council Offices in the coming months.

2010 District Populations

The City of Oakland last redistricted in 2013 with a council-based process. The populations of each district at that time were based on the 2010 Decennial Census.

As the following table shows, utilizing the American Community Survey (ACS) data vintage which would be used in that redistricting, Districts 6 and 7 both had more than 50% African American Citizen Voting Age Population (CVAP).

Population Growth and Estimated Deviations

The US Census has released in a "legacy format" the data from the decennial census, identifying the whole count of persons and where they resided as of April 1, 2020. Redistricting Partners has concluded the work of placing this data into the census blocks, block groups, and tracts.¹

This data represents the whole population data prior to a state required reallocation of prison population that will be conducted by the Statewide Database at UC Berkeley. This adjusted data will be completed in the coming weeks and updated counts will be provided at that time.

¹ These counts are based on the 2020 Census geography. There may be slight differences as many census blocks were consolidated.

Based on this data, the city has increased by 49,916 residents or 12.8% since the last decennial census. This is significantly higher than the state population change of 6.1%.

This population change has included a growth of 14,656 residents in District 3, and 10,192 residents in District 7.

With a total population of 440,749 the ideal population for any district would be 62,964. The seat with the greatest population is District 3 with a deviation of +14.1% and the district with the lowest population is District 4 with a deviation of -8.3%, placing the city at a total of 22.4% deviation, outside of the 10% required deviation range.

The data used to determine the size of ethnic and racial subgroups utilized for Voting Rights Act calculations have been finalized for the current redistricting cycle. Both the Latino and Asian CVAP grew, while the African American CVAP shrunk. Addressing these changes will likely be an important part of the coming redistricting process.
