Project Purpose


- Provide a secure service yard to accommodate EBMUD's pipeline maintenance and construction needs that are vital to support the community
- West Oakland location provides benefits
 - Fast emergency response time since the area has some of the oldest pipes in the EBMUD system
 - Secure stable employment opportunities within the West Oakland area






Project Location

- Property is close to Adeline Facilities and major transportation routes
 - Primary travel routes are on major arterial roads
- Maximizes operational efficiencies and storage for equipment, vehicles, and materials
- Proposed development is consistent with zoning of the parcel





Typical Facility Traffic Routes





Service Center Operations

- Normal Work Hours: 6 a.m. 5 p.m.
 - Emergency crews may use the facility outside of these hours to respond to pipeline breaks
- Staffing
 - 44 crew staff
 - 5 office & support staff

- Traffic analysis found traffic volume is comparable to prior use of the site

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
Air Quality Analysis

- The following were found to all be below the BAAQMD significance thresholds:
 - Criteria emissions
 - Greenhouse gas emissions
 - Health risk related to construction for cancer, noncancer, and PM_{2.5} significance
 - Health risk related to facility operation for cancer, noncancer, and PM_{2.5} significance

- May attract other businesses to the area








Minor Variance Requests
