

Context & Opportunity

- Subject site ("Parcel 2") is City owned, currently used for temporary construction staging
- Portion of site ("Parcel 1") currently under construction by another developer
- SAHA has ENA with City to develop affordable housing on Subject site
- Land area closest to the estuary will be retained by City



Local Activism & the People's Proposal

- Grass-roots coalition formed in 2015
- Led by Eastlake United for Justice (EUJ)
- Over 200 organizations and stakeholders
- Advocates for community-driven design and 100% affordable housing

Safety:


Desire for the building to feel **safe** and avoid spaces for people to hide.

Desire for opportunities for the community to **gather** and **connection** to adjacent housing building.












