Oakland residents who live in apartments can directly schedule a drop off and a curbside pickup appointment without property manager approval at no additional cost.*

DROP OFF

Schedule an appointment to bring up to 4 cubic yards of bulky waste to the Davis Street Resource Recovery Complex in San Leandro.



CURBSIDE PICKUP

Schedule a convenient bulky curbside appointment, where you can set out up to 4 cubic yards of bulky waste plus a limited number of larger items like mattresses, TVs, and tires.

Tie branches up (< 4' long and 6" wide). Bag plant debris in large paper gardening bags or cardboard boxes. Plant debris in plastic bags will be charged as extra trash.
