Need to Get Rid of Extra Waste and Bulky Junk?

Schedule a bulky drop off or curbside pickup at no additional cost.*

DROP OFF

Schedule an appointment to bring up to 4 cubic yards of bulky waste to the Davis Street Resource Recovery Complex in San Leandro.



CURBSIDE PICKUP

Schedule a convenient bulky curbside appointment, where you can set out up to 4 cubic yards of bulky waste plus a limited number of larger items.

*Costs to provide bulky pickup and drop off service are included in your quarterly trash bill. A second curbside pickup is also available annually to residents 45 days after use of one bulky drop off and curbside pickup.

Cart Set Out Instructions

Set your carts curbside on your sidewalks by 6 a.m. on your scheduled pickup day, with lids closed and opening facing the street. Collection service ends by 6 p.m. on your service day.

Empty Glass, Aluminum, Metal & Plastic Containers, Beverage & Soup Boxes & Clean Paper & Cardboard (bundled)

No food, liquid or diapers. Empty recyclables out of plastic bags and throw bags in the trash.



Place extra cardboard (bundled) here.



Place dry cell alkaline household batteries, bagged in a plastic bag, here.

Recycle Right!

All recycling should be empty, dry, and loose in the recycle cart. Plastic bags and film are trash.

COMPOST 堆肥 ABONO PHÂN HỮU CƠ



Food Scraps, Food-Soiled Paper, Plant Debris, Untreated Wood

No glass, plastic, or metal. No diapers or pet waste.



Place extra yard waste (bagged/bundled) here.



Tie branches up (< 4' long and 6" wide). Bag plant debris in large paper gardening bags or cardboard boxes. Plant debris in plastic bags will be charged as extra trash.

Never Pour Fats, Oil & Grease (FOG) Down the Drain!
