Proposal	Staff information update and request for DRC input on design guidelines for a proposal to redevelop the California College of Arts (CCA) Oakland Campus. The project includes: Demolition of 10 buildings and landscape features; Retention of 2 existing Landmark buildings for 10,435 square feet of office use. Development of two new buildings would include: 8 stories;462 residential units, 10% of which would be affordable to moderate income families; 6,310 square feet of café/retail use; 261 parking spaces;462 bicycle spaces; and 1.85 acres of private open space (accessible to the public) including rehabilitation of the existing Landmark view corridor. A project variant includes adding a 23 story tower with 126 additional dwelling units and a 200 foot total height.
