



Call to Order: By Chair Henderson at 6:05pm

1. Roll Call and Determination of Quorum

Chair Henderson determined a quorum present

2. Open Forum

Henry Fullmore, Oakland Resident – I've been doing my own footwork. (Referring to construction site/shipyards project at Hunter's Point in San Francisco) I've never seen that many (African-Americans) at a construction site in my life. The community has come together with a commission similar to CJOC and forced 51% instead of 50%. They monitor twice a week (Tuesdays and Thursdays) to ensure everything is being implemented. The general contractors are obeying every by-law the city (San Francisco) has established for them. I would like to see the same action taken here (in Oakland) especially at the Oakland Army Base. I would suggest that funds be set aside for the purpose of monitoring (contractors' activities/compliance). I visited a project here in Oakland, and was very disturbed to find union and non-union workers working together. I find that very odd.

Chairperson Mark Henderson – Who is doing the monitoring (at the San Francisco Hunter's point project)? Fullmore – They are using a Job resource center and a church that's also involved in hiring. Chair Henderson – So their resource center has a component that includes monitoring? Fullmore – Yes. Chair Henderson – What was the Oakland site you visited that had both union and non-union workers? Fullmore – It was on 24th street right off Grant. Chair Henderson – is that site associated with the activities at Oakland Army base? Fullmore – No, I just wanted to bring that up.

Commissioner Gordon – The project he's referring to is the San Francisco building/construction trade ordinance that was passed within San Francisco city and county. It identifies prioritization for certain communities. Five communities have been identified by zip code for prioritization: Bayview/Hunter's point, Fillmore, Ocean View, Sunnydale, and Chinatown.

4. Consideration of Minutes of the Meetings held on August 21, 2014 ACTION and September 18, 2014

Al Auletta (Workforce development) clarified that the commission could not approve the minutes from the 9/18/2014 CJOC meeting due to the lack of quorum at this meeting. Commission agreed to take action on the 8/21/2014 CJOC minutes only.

MOTION: Moved Beveridge and seconded by Morodomi to accept the minutes from the 8/21/2014 CJOC meeting.

VOTE: ACCEPTED UNANIMOUSLY. Minutes of 8/21/2014 CJOC meeting accepted.

5. Consideration of West Oakland Hiring Practices

ACTION

Chair Henderson: I would ask that either Commissioners Beveridge or Gordon refresh the committee on the history of this subject and why we are considering this issue.

Commissioner Beveridge: The notion of preferences for West Oakland as a neighborhood came out of (a few years of) discussions within the working group as the Jobs policy was being developed. Many perspectives on how to provide advantage to disadvantaged neighborhoods, urban areas, and zip codes came out of those discussions. There was an understanding on many fronts that West Oakland being right next to the port and army base had suffered a legacy of problems from those institutions and had also had a great loss of employment when the army and navy supply centers closed. Through the discussions, a consensus document agreed to by all the parties (involved was produced that basically addressed "How many things can we agree on?" prior to the drafting of the Jobs Policy. The document contained a variety of elements that did not make it through the process of drafting the agreements, and West Oakland representatives as well as West Oakland works had a priority hiring opportunity for the people of West Oakland as their top priority. It would require that a West Oakland resident be considered first for a job opportunity; only if a qualified West Oakland resident was not available would the search extend to the city of Oakland. That is the genesis of this notion, from a consensus document amongst all parties involved in discussions on job policies in Oakland.

Chair Henderson - Given how important (West Oakland hiring preferences) is to you, why did you sign the agreement? Beveridge — My feeling at the time was that without an agreement of any kind we had no legal standing at all. If you don't sign the agreement you have no right to complain about how it's being executed. Ultimately, we decided that having some legal standing was better than nothing. That is why we signed it.

Commissioner Gordon: As Commissioner Beveridge said, we had a consensus amongst ourselves in the working group of a list of things we wanted to see. Having the (West Oakland priority hiring opportunity) subtracted out of the Jobs Policy of a Corporate agreement is unacceptable given the history over the last twenty years of construction jobs not being given to communities like West Oakland. Chair Henderson - I'm hearing two different things being emphasized "African American" and "Zip Code". Gordon - I always used the term zip code when I brought up the issue in the meetings. I know that (based on) proposition 209 you cannot use race as a preference. Commissioner Cluver - Even if we all support having specific targets for West Oakland hiring I think we have (at least) two logistical problems: First, if we recommend that City Council make a change then City Council will have to go back to the developer and renegotiate that with them. The other problem we have is that most of the contracts have been let for the horizontal and you can't change those, the contractual relationships have been signed. Is this something that would be applicable in the vertical construction? Even so, that is something developer would have to agree to, the developer makes the ultimate decision (on whether or not to renegotiate agreements). The City cannot unilaterally change an aspect of that agreement.

Commissioner Morodomi: If we are considering adopting a recommendation to modify the vertical construction jobs policy I would like to table this action item because Prologis is not present; that particular policy impacts their construction of the warehouses; they have made a significant commitment to the project under certain assumptions which include the policies that govern their construction work. City Attorney Julian Gross - Any contracts can be amended if the parties to it agree. For the Operation Jobs Policy and Vertical Jobs Policy the parties that would need to agree to a change would be the City Council and the other party to the LDDA. Morodomi – I'm looking at the establishing ordinates and wondering if this particular function is in the purview of the commission? I don't see modification to policy stated anywhere. Chair Henderson – I would say that (the commission) is not here to modify but we are here to recommend. We are the voice of the people; if they feel this modification is necessary we can make the recommendation.

MOTION: Amended motion moved by Camacho and seconded by Gordon: The Community Jobs Oversight Commission recommends that City staff propose amendments to the

Construction Jobs Policies to provide preference for West Oakland residents, as is included in the Operations Jobs Policies, and present those proposed amendments to parties to relevant contracts; and upon request, to report back to the Community Jobs Oversight Commission, including presentation of language under construction.

VOTE: In Favor – 6 Votes: Beveridge, Bolton, Camacho, Cluver, Gordon, O'Hara. Opposed: 1 Vote: Morodomi. Abstain – 1 Vote: Henderson.

Proposed amended motion passed by majority.

6. Grievance policy for West Oakland Jobs Center

Auletta – We're trying to set up a client feedback system so that people feel like they can express any concerns they may have in regards to the services they are receiving. Our new program Director Jolena Bonilla will help draft that feedback system/grievance policy. It's really to get a sense of how our clients are feeling about the services they are getting and establishing steps for them to express any concerns they might have.

Cluver – does this commission have a role in the grievance policy or is that a separate policy to be handled outside the commission? Auletta – We are always open to feedback from the members of this commission, but I think this is more administrative, an operational matter for the West Oakland Job Resource Center.

Chair Henderson – We will have staff draft a document regarding the grievance policy to bring to next meeting as discussion item for review. Henry Fullmore – I suggest you draw up the grievance policy to include the (Oakland Army Base) construction site; the developers, contractors and sub-contractors.

7. Counting local hire hours earned by lower tier subs

Cliff Kunkel (Senior Project Manager, Joint venture design/build contract at OAB) — We have two policies within the city we are trying to comply with: the Jobs Policy and the Local Business Enterprise/Small Business Enterprise Program. As we sub-contract more and more work into smaller and smaller firms, we get into situations where a sub-contractor may only have two or three employees. They are Oakland certified businesses but one or all three of their workers may not be Oakland residents. While they satisfy the spirit of hiring Oakland businesses, they don't satisfy the Jobs Policy, which requires that every sub-contractor at every tier for every craft be in compliance with the Jobs Policy. We are asking you consider is eliminating the "at any tier" phrase within the Jobs Policy and restrict compliance to primary sub-contract level.

Commissioner Bolton - What if the term "at any tier" said "at any tier where and when practical"?

Cluver: My suggestion is that we defer to (Contracts and Compliance), have them look at this issue and draft a potential solution for us to review at the next meeting. Once again, the City has to agree to the recommendation. Chair Henderson – we will make it an action item for the next CJOC meeting.

re: City's compliance options for Oakland Army Base Jobs Policies

Pursuant to the request from the Community Jobs Oversight Commission, this memorandum provides an overview of the City's legal options in cases of noncompliance with the Construction Jobs Policy for Public Improvements ("Jobs Policy") for the Oakland Army Base Project (the "Project").¹

This memo covers only the primary legal options available to the City; additional legal options may be available in certain cases.

The Jobs Policy and the Project's Design-Build Contract contain several important provisions regarding compliance.

(1) Compliance is determined for each contractor working on the Project, regardless of tier. If a contractor has completed its work on a contract on the Project, then a compliance determination is made for that work. (See Jobs Policy Section III.A.1; the definition of "Contractor"; and inclusion of Jobs Policy as a material term of each contract and subcontract.)

¹This memorandum does *not* address the following matters:

[•] compliance mechanisms regarding violations of other Project jobs policies, including policies covering vertical construction and operational jobs;

[·] compliance mechanisms regarding violations of the Project Labor Agreement for the Project;

[·] compliance mechanisms for violations of the Project's Property Management Agreement;

monitoring and reporting systems for the Jobs Policy;

[•] operations or activities of the West Oakland Jobs Resource Center;

role of the Community Jobs Oversight Commission;

[•] operations or activities of the Contracts & Compliance Unit of the City Administrator's Office; or

[•] compliance mechanisms for violations of the Project's Design-Build Contract *other than* violations of the Jobs Policy (such as the local business utilization requirements).

- (2) Compliance regarding local and disadvantaged hiring requirements is determined for each trade in which a contractor works. Hours a contractor works in one trade may not be aggregated with the contractor's work hours in another trade. (See Jobs Policy Sections III.C.1 and III.C.2, establishing targeted percentages "For each construction trade in which a Contractor performs Project Construction Work...")
- (3) The City is empowered to take certain types of direct action against a contractor that is out of compliance, rather than having to take action against its construction manager or the design-build contractor. (See Jobs Policy section IV.E, "Third Party Beneficiaries.")
- (4) For failure of a contractor to either satisfy the percentage goals or follow the required processes, the City's primary legal remedy is assessment of liquidated damages. The Jobs Policy establishes that in each trade, each contractor must either meet the specified percentage goals for local and for disadvantaged workers, or utilize specified recruitment procedures for all hiring. (See Jobs Policy sec. III.A.)
 - ➤ If a contractor does not attain compliance through one of these alternative approaches, the City may assess liquidated damages against the contractor, in the amount of \$20 for each hour by which the contractor was short of the percentage requirements. (See Jobs Policy sec. IV.F.1.)
 - Liquidated damages are assessed through withholding of payment to a contractor that has not complied. (See Design-Build Contract sec. A.9.5.1 ("The City may withhold a payment ... due to their determination that ... the Design-Builder or any subcontractor has not complied with the Construction Jobs Policy."); see also sec. 5.1.4.)
- (5) For failure to follow other requirements of the Jobs Policy, the City has several remedies available.
 - ➤ The City may withhold payment for work performed by a subcontractor that is not in compliance with the Jobs Policy. (See Design-Build Contract sec. A.9.5.1.)
 - ➤ The City can require its construction manager or the design-build contractor to bring the contractor into compliance. The Design-Build Contract includes several statements requiring contractor and subcontractor compliance with the Jobs Policy. (See Design-Build Contract, Articles ii.2, 5.5.1, A.9.3.1.) The City may also take direct legal action against a subcontractor to obtain compliance, including pursuit of a court order requiring compliance, if necessary. (See Jobs Policy sec. IV.F.2.)
