

# Measure Q Hiring Metrics (As of August 7, 2023)

Priority Neighborhood Rankings: The Priority Neighborhoods layer gives each census tract in Oakland a level of priority between lowest and highest determined by seven demographic factors:

- People of Color [25% of score]
- Low-Income Households (<50% Area Median Income) [25% of score]
- People with Disability [10% of score]
- Seniors 65 Years and Over [10% of score]
- Single Parent Families [10% of score]
- Severely Rent-Burdened Households [10% of score]
- Low Educational Attainment (less than a bachelor's degree) [10% of score]




