



All multifamily buildings receive bulky pickup service.

Bulky pickup service includes 1.5 cubic yards of trash per unit plus 1 large appliance, 2 tires, 2 mattresses and 2 carpets per pickup.

Curbside Collection: Easy curbside access for 20 units or fewer.

Debris Box Collection: Suggested for buildings with 15 or more units.

Resident Self-Schedule: Buildings 5 to 14 units without on-site property managers. Submit a waiver to allow resident scheduling

Minimum Trash Service

The Oakland Municipal Code(OMC) requires multi-family property owners to subscribe to the equivalent of no less than 20 gallons of trash service per unit, per week. One cubic yard of service is 200 gallons. This ensures everyone in Oakland has space to dispose of their trash which prevents overflowing trash containers and illegal dumping. Litter dumped in the street can attract pests which spread disease and cause soil and water contamination.

Price per unit for recycling: There is per unit charge per month for unlimited weekly recycling collection. If your property needs more recycling service, contact California Waste Solutions at 510-625-5263.

Unlimited containers for compost collection once a week is included with the cost of trash service. Property managers are required to provide adequate compost collection for the compostable material generated on the property. Order more or larger compost containers from WMAC at no cost.

Environmental Enforcement:

The City of Oakland Environmental Enforcement Officers are working hard to enforce mandatory waste collection and stop illegal dumping. Together, we can keep Oakland clean.

Know the rules:

- Property owners can be fined for not providing adequate waste service. It is the property owner's responsibility to have enough trash, recycle, and compost service to meet residents' needs. If your property needs more service, call WMAC to increase trash and compost service and CWS to increase recycle service. Increasing compost and recycle collection will have no impact on your monthly bill.
- Property owners can receive fines for material dumped by tenants or material dumped by past tenants as part of tenant move out (Oakland Municipal Code 8.11.550).

Report it!

Key Service - Service provider will provide a lock that they have a key to.



Push Service - Service provider
will collect your container from
your property, empty it, and return
it to its original location.
