Plastic bags cause damage or other challenges at the recycling processing plant. Recycling in a tied plastic bag might be sorted out as trash. Ensure your bottles and cans are recycled by putting them loose in your cart.



# Let's Break it Down!

Please make sure cardboard boxes are broken down (no larger than 3ft x 3ft) and recycling is free of plastic film and foam packaging.

## Keep Recyclables Loose!

Plastic bags do not belong in your recycling cart. Make sure you empty your recyclables into your grey recycling cart. Put plastic bags in the trash.

Also remember to keep your recyclables empty, clean and dry.
