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<u>Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)</u> for Minor Excavation (X) Permits

1. What is an Excavation (X) Permit?

Answer: Excavation (X) Permit allows a contractor with the appropriate contractor's license (see question 3 below) to excavate in the City right of way for installing private underground utilities. Applicant must request for inspections at least 48 hours in advance of scheduled work. City Inspector will inspect the material, construction method, connections, paving, and requests compaction test results.

Note that the City provides two types of Excavation Permit applications. One that can be applied for by any contractor with the appropriate contractor's license (minor excavation), and a separate application that only utility companies or franchisees and contractors that work with utility companies with approved utility plans may apply for (utility excavation).

Examples of scopes of work matching a minor excavation permit include soil borings, underground storage (UGS) tank excavations, monitoring well installation/destruction, potholing, water meter repair, and gas meter repair. Examples of scopes of work matching a utility excavation permit include new water meter installation, new gas meter installation, and utility trenching. 2. How much does a Minor Excavation (X) permit cost?

Answer: Rates are shown in "How Fees Are Calculated For Minor Excavation (X) Permits" in Page 4.

3. Who can apply for a Minor Excavation (X) permit?

Answer: The following contractor licenses are allowed to perform excavation work:

Scope of Work	Contractor License Classifications
City Right-of-Way	A, C-42, C-57

In addition, contractor must have current valid Oakland Business License. If a homeowner wants to be a permit runner for the contractor, a signed company letter authorization from the contractor is required to allow the homeowner to obtain the permit under the contractor's license.

4. When should I provide a bond?

Answer: For minor excavation work, a bond is not required if the minor excavation work is related to a signed and recorded Indenture Agreement made between a Property Owner and the City. Otherwise per OMC 12.12.022, the bond shall be in the sum of \$25,000 or as determined by the Director of Public Works. This is interpreted as either \$25,000 or the approved engineer's estimate, whichever is greater, and which may be added as cash to the permit. Alternatively, a security bond may be submitted to the City's cashier. Cash bond and securities will be released to the Applicant when permit is finalized. A processing fee will be due.



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5. What are the City's Standard Insurance Requirements?

Answer: The City's Standard Insurance Requirements include:

The permittee/property owner shall maintain fully in force and effect at all times that the encroachment occupies the public right-of-way good and sufficient public liability insurance in a face amount not less than \$300,000.00 for each occurrence, and property damage insurance in a face amount not less than \$50,000.00 for each occurrence, both including contractual liability, insuring the City of Oakland, its officers, agents, employees, and volunteers against any and all claims arising out of the existence of the encroachment in the public right-of-way, as respects liabilities assume under this permit, and that a certificate of such insurance and subsequent notices of the renewal thereof, shall be filed with the City Engineer of the City of Oakland, and that such certificate shall state that the insurance coverage shall not be canceled or be permitted to lapse without thirty calendar (30) days written notice to the City Engineer. The permittee/property owner also agrees that the City of Oakland may review the type and amount of insurance required of the permittee/property owner annually and may require the permittee/property owner to increase the amount of and/or change the type of insurance coverage required.

The foregoing endorsements and the following endorsement must be specified in the certificate of insurance:

"Not withstanding any other provision in this policy, the insurance afforded hereunder to the City of Oakland shall be primary as to any other insurance or reinsurance covering or available to the City of Oakland, and such other insurance or reinsurance shall not be required to contribute to any liability of loss until and unless the appropriate limit of liability afforded hereunder is exhausted."

6. If I don't need the Excavation (X) Permit(s), can I request a refund?

Answer: A refund request form must be reviewed by the City inspector(s) and approved by the supervisor. Refund requests are available on the City Cashier, second floor of 250 Frank Ogawa Plaza.

7. How to request inspections for Excavation (X) Permits?

Answer: Please request for inspections two business days **prior** to start of work or else subject to fine. To schedule an inspection, please see below:

8. How can I contact USA (Underground Service Alert)?

Answer: USA is Underground Service Alert (USA) and 811 is the phone number to call before digging to protect yourself and others from unintentionally hitting underground utility lines. USA numbers are required in X permit applications.



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9. I want to see the existing utilities within my site area, where can I access this information?

Answer: Please visit http://oakbec.s3.amazonaws.com/MapLanding/maps/DEC.html and type in your site address to view existing utilities. Click on the icon. Scroll down and click on "sewer sheets" to see existing utilities. You may also click on the icon to see location of your parcel in relation to existing utilities. Please note that the sewer sheets are for *reference* only, and deviations may exist from the *actual* utility location.

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How Fees Are Calculated For Minor Excavation (X) Permits

The fees for Minor Excavation (X) Permits are calculated based upon the approved Oakland Master Fee Schedule. The tables below show fees based on the 2022/2023 Fiscal Year Master Fee Schedule effective February 21, 2023.
