

## Projects with a valuation over \$100,000

Projects with a valuation over \$100,000+ shall be required to submit prior to FINAL approval to the permit inspector, the following:

1- East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) Private Sewer Lateral (PSL) Certificate. As per Regional Ordinance issued by EBMUD, projects with a valuation <u>over \$100,000+</u> shall submit a PSL Certificate to the permit inspector for verification of compliance with EBMUD Regional Ordinance.

ADUs are not exempt from PSL requirements, and they may need a separate SL permit from DOT.

2- City of Oakland Sidewalk Certification- Department of Transportation Effective July 9, 2019: For construction projects with a valuation over \$100,000+ or before a title transfer may be completed, property owners must complete an inspection, and any necessary repairs and upgrades, to bring abutting sidewalks into compliance. (Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 12 Section 12.04.380)

All property owners must apply for a Sidewalk Certificate of Compliance with OakDOT Permits via: <u>mailto:DOTOnlinePermits@oaklandca.gov</u>; <u>concurrent with the permitting</u> <u>process for a \$100,000+ renovation</u> or prior to the first close of escrow on the property. The compliance process will depend on the condition of your sidewalk.

ADUs are exempt from the Sidewalk Certification ordinance.

Projects with a valuation over \$100,000+ will not receive a FINAL until the above has been completed and verification has been provided to the permit inspector.
