Pursuant to Rule 13 of the Redistricting Commission's Rules of Procedures, Commissioners shall verbally report any contacts with the purpose of influencing the decision-making authority of the Commission. Contacts shall include, but is not limited to, verbal or written communications from a City Council Member, School Board Member, locally elected official, public entity, partisan lobbyist, or individual speaking on behalf of the aforementioned offices or entities.

The Commissioners will provide oral updates on outreach efforts including feedback received at previously held redistricting workshops.

The Commission will receive public testimony regarding proposed draft maps. Each member of the public will be given 2 minutes to speak regarding any proposed map.

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After all public comments have been received, the Commission may discuss public comments or concerns. The Commission will continue to receive public input after this meeting. The Commission may take action regarding any proposed map including eliminating maps from consideration, review maps proposed prior to this meeting, discuss details of the maps under consideration, may direct or make changes to any map under consideration, and may direct the creation of new maps.

 - Draft Map E this map was requested by the Commission using the following criteria: Do not have a "hills only" district; Keep other neighborhoods intact as requested, including: Glenview, District 2, Rockridge, West Oakland, Dimond, Lake Merritt (around the Lake Merritt shore), Piedmont Pines; Make the density of each district closer to average (closer than allowed deviation), adjusted for economic, racial diversity, includes business districts, environmental areas/parks without diluting the relative voting strength of communities of interest; Keep an influence level of 30%.
 - <u>Draft Map F</u> this map was requested by the Commission using the following criteria: Use Draft Map A as a guideline; Do not have a "hills only" district; Make the density of each district closer to average (closer than allowed deviation), adjusted for economic, racial diversity, includes business districts, environmental areas/parks without diluting the relative voting strength of communities of interest; Change the map identification from letters to a letter plus a number format (i.e. A1, B2, C3, etc.)
 - Draft Map G this map was requested by the Commission using the following criteria: Use Draft Map B as a guideline; Make the density of each district closer to average (closer than allowed deviation), adjusted for economic, racial diversity, includes business districts, environmental areas/parks without diluting the relative voting strength of communities of interest; Keep other neighborhoods intact as requested, including: Glenview, District 2, Rockridge, West Oakland, Dimond, Lake Merritt (around the Lake Merritt shore), Piedmont Pines; Change the map identification from letters to a letter plus a number format (i.e. A1, B2, C3, etc.)
 - <u>Draft Map H</u> this map was requested by the Commission using the following criteria: Use Draft Map D as a guideline; Make the density of each district closer to average (closer than allowed deviation), adjusted for economic, racial diversity, includes business districts, environmental areas/parks without diluting the relative voting strength of communities of interest; Keep other neighborhoods intact as requested, including: Glenview, District 2, Rockridge, West Oakland, Dimond, Lake Merritt (around the Lake

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Merritt shore), Piedmont Pines; Change the map identification from letters to a letter plus a number format (i.e. A1, B2, C3, etc.)

- <u>Draft Map I</u> this map was requested by the Commission using the following criteria: Use Draft Map E as a guideline; Keep the Black Cultural Zone intact; Unify Dimond, Laurel, Allendale, and Bartlett neighborhoods into one district in a predominantly "hills" district.
- <u>Draft Map J</u> this map was requested by the Commission using the following criteria: Use Draft Map E as a guideline; Keep the Black Cultural Zone intact; Unify Dimond, Laurel, Allendale, and Bartlett neighborhoods into one district in a predominantly "flats" district.
- <u>Draft Map K</u> this map was produced by the Commission's technical consultants using the following criteria: Use Draft Map H as a guideline; Keep the Black Cultural Zone intact; Unify Dimond, Laurel, Allendale, and Bartlett neighborhoods into one district in a predominantly "flats" district.
