Reminders When Selecting Your Medical Plan

Medical plan availability is based on your home or work zip code. Some medical plans require monthly employee contributions which are deducted from your paycheck.


When selecting your medical plan ensure you:

4. Review the monthly employee contribution for the medical plan you select.
