I understand that completed affidavits and disclosure reports shall be made publicly available to the public upon request after consultation with the City Attorney and any contractor who willfully or recklessly files a false affidavit or other statement or fails to file the required disclosure shall be subject to termination of the contract with the City. I understand that the City Administrator may take action to terminate the contract, and the City Attorney or any Oakland resident may bring action to mandate disclosure or correct any misstatement as well as reasonable attorney's fees and costs.

I understand that I can make voluntary contributions to the established Fund 2422, the Slavery Era Disclosure Fund to promote healing and assist the City in rectifying and remedying some of the legacies of the shameful commerce in slavery. Contributions of up to \$50,000 may be accepted by the City Administrator on behalf of the City without City Council action, pursuant to Administrative Instruction No. 1052, effective February 14, 2008.

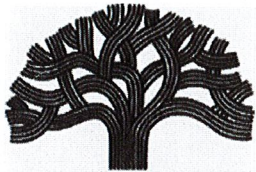

ADDENDUM

CITY OF OAKLAND AFFIDAVIT DISCLOSING SLAVERY ERA PARTICIPATION, INVESTMENTS, OR PROFITS

BofA Securities, Inc. (“BofA Securities”) is a direct, wholly owned subsidiary of NB Holdings Corporation (“NB Holdings”). NB Holdings is a direct, wholly owned subsidiary of Bank of America Corporation. Bank of America Corporation (the “Corporation”) is a publicly held company whose shares are traded on the New York Stock Exchange and has no parent corporation. Based on the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission Rules regarding beneficial ownership, Berkshire Hathaway Inc., 3555 Farnam Street, Omaha, Nebraska 68131, beneficially owns greater than 10% of Bank of America Corporation’s outstanding common stock, which is a large and diversified, publicly-traded institution. The Corporation and its subsidiaries including BofA Securities, is a global franchise, serving customers and clients around the world with operations in all 50 U.S. states, the District of Columbia, and more than 40 foreign countries. Given the size and breadth of the Bank of America family of companies, the extensive number of predecessor companies and the lack of availability of records for all predecessors dating back the slavery era, it is not reasonably possible to perform definitive due diligence across the full panoply of predecessor companies. In 2005, the Corporation engaged the research firm, Heritage Research Center, Ltd. to perform an extensive review of predecessor companies existing at the time to determine ties with slavery. The Heritage firm reported that they “did not identify any instances or occasions in which any Bank of America legacy banks made a profit from slavery.” The firm found examples of abolitionist sentiment among founders and directors of several of the bank’s predecessors, and strong objections to doing business with commercial interests involved in slavery in the bank’s predecessors’ histories. The firm also found two connections to slavery in the histories of the bank’s predecessors. In 1863, two predecessor banks of Bank of America – Boatmen’s Bank and Southern Bank in St. Louis – joined four other businesses in taking a security interest against all of the property of Charles McLaran for a past due debt. Mr. McLaran apparently owned slaves and the category “slaves” was listed in the agreement among the types of property pledged as security. That same year, Mr. McLaran paid his debts in full and the institutions released their claim on his property. At no time did any of the businesses own any of the slaves. In 1840, John Forsyth, Secretary of State of the United States, proposed to the directors of Bank of the Metropolis in Washington, D.C. to pledge slaves as security against an amount in dispute over a dishonored note, and the board agreed in principle to the proposal. The available evidence suggests that Forsyth and the directors reached an alternative arrangement several weeks later, and that the bank “did not file or receive a mortgage with Forsyth’s slaves as collateral.

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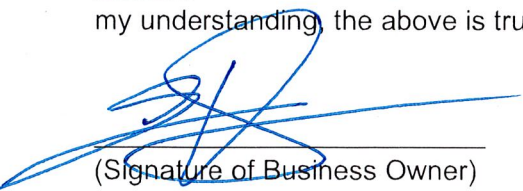

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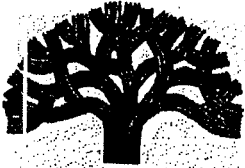

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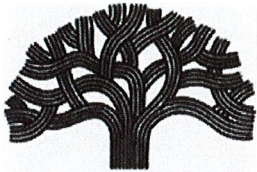
