Substantial Amendment to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024/2025 Annual Action Plan (AAP) and Citizen Participation Plan

Summary: The City of Oakland's Housing and Community Development Department (HCD) receives annual entitlement funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), including:

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME)
- Housing Opportunities for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA)
- Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG)

Oakland HCD's Five-Year Consolidated Plan includes a Strategic Plan that details the needs and goals for use of CDBG, HOME, HOPWA and ESG for the period of 2020 through 2025. The Annual Action Plan (AAP) outlines the specific programs and activities that Oakland HCD is funding with the entitlement funding to meet the goals described in the Consolidated Plan. Any substantial changes in funding, goals or activities require a Substantial Amendment to the Consolidated Plan and/or the Annual Action Plan (AAP) as set forth in 24 CFR Part 91.

The purpose of this Substantial Amendment to the Fiscal Year (FY) 2024/2025 AAP is to:

- Adjust funding allocations,
- Add project activities, and
- Adjust backup activity list

The draft Substantial Amendment to the FY 2024/202 AAP updates Resolution 90372 to allow for the reallocation of funding to high-priority projects and ensuring compliance with strict federal spending deadlines and avoiding recapture of unspent funds. The proposed changes would alleviate some challenges associated with expenditure of federal grant funds by:

- Authorizing the City Administrator to reprogram funds without returning to Council while still complying with competitive bidding/environmental review requirements and
- Modifying the "substantial amendment" threshold in the Citizen Participation Plan from 25% of an allocation to 20% of total annual grant award to reduce administrative delays

These updates align with HUD technical assistance and address various program-specific challenges (e.g., CDBG's 15% public services cap, HOPWA's 3-year spending window, and federal environmental review requirements). By streamlining administrative processes, the

City of Oakland aims to deploy its federal grant funds efficiently—directly supporting Oakland residents—while maintaining transparency through the Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) and public engagement.

This substantial amendment reflects changes to sections:

- 1. Citizen Participation Plan (Part D., Section 4.)
- 2. Exhibit A (Funding Allocations and Backup Activities)

All other portions of the 2024/2025 Annual Action Plan currently remain unchanged.
