### Engagement OCIC - 5/9/23

- Need to focus on street safety.
- Do we have data on what improvements are most effective? (Signs vs. crossings vs. lights) in Oakland Chinatown? Look into data on scramble effectiveness.
- When I've seen accidents, it's people jaywalking. At scrambles, people need education on when to go/ how to comply with rules.
- Reduce speed of drivers when they come through Chinatown or reduce number of drivers in Chinatown
- City should prohibit parking in red zones.
- Any way to improve monitoring of streets, particularly where OPD has identified hotspots?


Takeaways

  - \*Applications might not be successful




## **Ranked Choice Votes**



Increase scramble intersections, increased pedestrian safety at intersections with 7th Street and 8th Streets



Scramble intersections, increasing visibility of intersections, pedestrian safety zones, yield signage, bike lanes






