



WHAT'S HAPPENING AT THE PEC?

The Public Ethics Commission meets monthly to consider matters related to campaign finance, transparency, lobbying, and government ethics laws. Here are some highlighted items that the Commission will be discussing at its upcoming meeting on August 9:

Limited Public Financing Act of 2024

The Commission will consider recommending to the City Council that it establish a limited campaign public financing program for the 2024 election cycle only, similar to the Limited Public Financing Act (LPF) Program used in 2022. The proposal recommends spending up to \$155,000 on the program from the discretionary funding budgeted to the PEC.



Amendments to the Lobbyist Registration Act

The Commission will consider recommending to the City Council amendments to the Lobbyist Registration Act (LRA), including amendments incorporating the annual registration fee which the City Council recently adopted, a policy to waive or reduce the annual registration fee for some lobbyists, and other changes.
