## Dog Play Area Regulations

- Dog Play Area users and dog owners assume all risk related to Dog Play Area use
- Small dog area is designed for dogs under 25 pounds and elderly/infirmed dogs
- This is a Community Maintenance Dog Play Area. Users are fully responsible for keeping ground clean, weed removal and removing graffiti within the runs
- Dog owners must clean up after their dogs immediately (O.M.C 6.04.080) Dog owner is responsible for bringing supplies to pick up dog stool
- Limit three dogs per user
- Puppies under 4 months old prohibited
- Dogs must be leashed to and from Dog Play Area
- Dog owner must be in Dog Play Area with dog at all times
- Keep dogs in sight and maintain voice control
- Dogs must be licensed, wear dog tags, and have current vaccinations
- Dogs in heat are prohibited
- Un-neutered male dogs prohibited
- Dogs showing repeated aggressive behavior must be removed
- Excessive barking must be controlled (O.M.C 6.04.310)
- Spiked or pinched collars prohibited
- Food, smoking and alcohol are prohibited
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult
- Children must not run, carry food, sit on ground, yell, use wheeled toys, or throw anything. Dog Play Area is designated for dog exercise, not as a children's playground
- Anyone who intentionally and maliciously abuses injures or neglects (including not providing adequate food, water, shelter and/or medical care) an animal can be punished as a misdemeanor or felony. (California Penal Code 597)
- If you feel unsafe in the Dog Play Area leave the area and report the problem to Oakland Police (510) 777-3333
