All other camps are held in Joaquin Miller Park at or near the Redwood Glen Group Picnic Site on Skyline Blvd.

The drop off and pick up location is a large, dirt turn out situated between the entrance to EBRPD Robert's Park and The Chabot Space and Science Center on Skyline Blvd. It is on the *opposite side of the street* from the two landmarks.

Shake, Rattle and Roll will no longer have drop off and pick up at the Ranger Station location on Sanborn Drive. The drop off and pick up location for SSR is the same as Touch the Earth, explained above.

*** Extended Care includes before drop off at 8am and aftercare 4pm to 6pm in Joaquin Miller Park. Young Naturalist aftercare is to 5pm. A late fee of \$10 will be added every 15 minutes after 6pm.
