Measure DD was passed in 2002. The voters approved \$198 million in bond funds in order (in the words of the bond measure) "to improve water quality; provide educational and recreational facilities for children; clean up Lake Merritt; restore Oakland's creeks, waterfront and Estuary; preserve and acquire open space; renovate parks; provide safe public spaces"


Nearly 20 years later, Oakland Public Works is near finishing many of the projects originally listed in the measure. The results of many of these are on display at Lake Merritt. There are now still funds left over in various portions of the bond measure (which was divided into various categories). Looking at the category that addressed the Lake, the Measure DD Coalition is looking to use the leftover money from this category to further other improvements.
