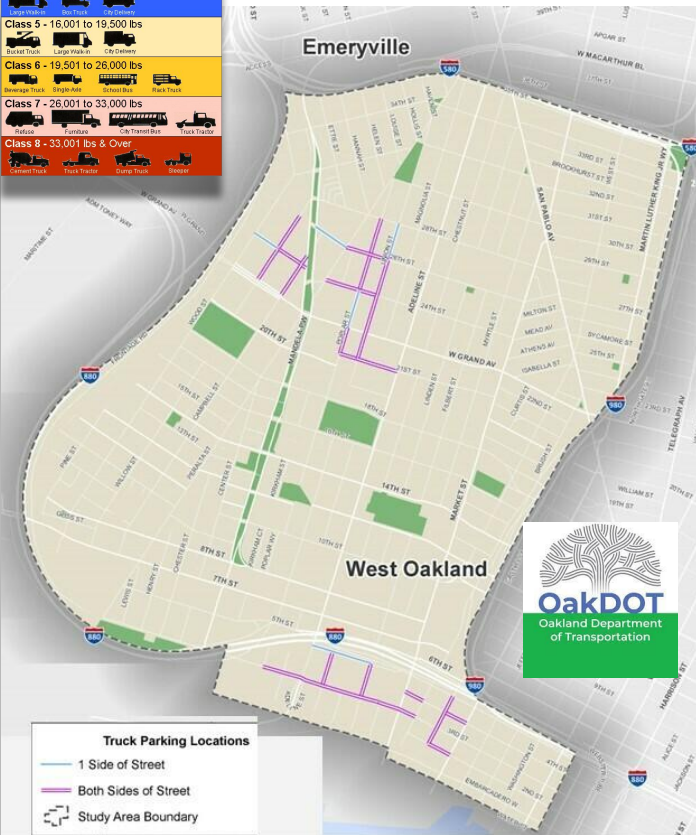

“Where is truck parking is allowed?”

In West Oakland, special truck parking rules apply. Truck parking is prohibited in West Oakland except where signs are posted that specifically allow truck parking, OMC 10.28.145 ([Ordinance No. 13686](#)). Unattached trailers are prohibited from parking on city streets except while loading and unloading, effective citywide, OMC 10.28.160.”

Class 1 - 6,000 lbs & Less
Minivan, Cargo Van, SUV, Pickup Truck
Class 2 - 6,001 to 10,000 lbs
Minivan, Cargo Van, Full-Size Pickup, SUV Van
Class 3 - 10,001 to 14,000 lbs
Van Box, Box Truck, City Delivery, Heavy Duty Pickup
Class 4 - 14,001 to 16,000 lbs
Box Truck
Class 5 - 16,001 to 19,500 lbs
Box Truck, Large Van/Box, City Delivery
Class 6 - 19,501 to 26,000 lbs
Box Truck, Single Unit, Service Bus, Back Truck
Class 7 - 26,001 to 33,000 lbs
Box Truck, Flatbed, City Transit Bus, Truck Trailer
Class 8 - 33,001 lbs & Over
Container Truck, Truck Trailer, Crane Truck, Heavy
